The treatment is Truvada.




It does not protect against other sexually transmitted infections.

Inform all the doctors you take the Prep.

The Hiv :


In our body the HIV attaches to the CD4 cells, enters and then multiplies. The HIV grows and the CD4 cells dies.




The CD4 protect us from the diseases.

The action of the Prep :






With the PREP, the HIV not be able to multiply in our body and to settle there. He disappears.




How to take the Prep :

Do not panic ! these effects disappear after a few weeks.



What happens if you forget the Prep ?




The effectiveness of the Prep decreases if you forget it.
